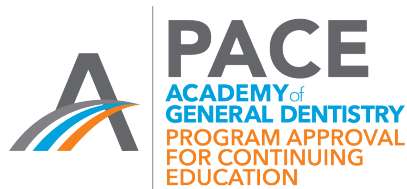


COURSE OVERVIEW:
