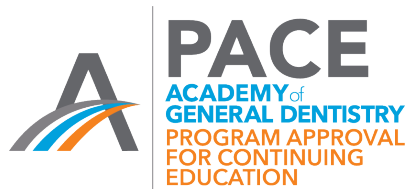
# WHAT CAN A PROSTHODONTIST DO FOR YOUR PATIENTS?
